First month of your stay	€2,220 or €75/day
Month 2 and onwards	€1,200/month or €40/day

<b>Personnel costs</b>	
Student assistant	€17 per hour (€18 as of 1 April 2025) (average hours: 20 hours/month)

<b>Research cost contribution (fellowship funding)</b>
If applicable, please calculate research costs (e.g. licenses, special software costs) and conference resources/consumables individually.

<b>Events</b>	
Refreshments during break (drinks, biscuits etc. – according to the “Repräsentationsrichtlinien” of the University of Passau, currently only available in <a href="#">German</a> )	€10/person per break (a.m. and p.m., for all <u>active</u> participants)
Accommodation for participants (Hotel, AirBnB etc.)	€90/night
Hosting of guest lecturers/visiting scholars	up to €130 for honorarium (plus travel expenses and accommodation costs including daily allowance)
